All roads lead to the Woodlands House Hotel, Adare on Friday 17th June in the Ryan Suite at 9pm for a night of nostalgia and celebration at the Granagh/Ballingarry GAA Club 2021 medal presentation function. Players and supporters will be celebrating the achievements of 2021 as well as looking forward to the club hurling and football championship due to commence in early July. We will honour the many acclaimed and outstanding successes of the Junior B Footballers achieving a West and County championship double, reaching the Munster Championship Final where they were most unlucky to go under to Randal Og, Cork after a replay and their counterparts in hurling winning the delayed 2020 West Championship title.

The fine displays given by the Intermediate hurlers reaching the County Championship semi final for the first time since 2018 where they went under to eventual winners Effin by two points, reaching the West Senior Hurling League/Championship Final where they went under to Adare by four points, winning the Jim (Twin) Lynch Memorial and Hennessy Cup. Our under 21 hurlers with only a panel of 17 players fought a great campaign to reach the County B Final where they defeated neighbours Dromin/Athlaca 0-18 to 0-7 to capture the Club's first county 15-a-side under 21 hurling championship title.

Limerick Claim Fourth Straight Munster Title and Inaugural Mackey Cup

Hearty congratulations to the Limerick hurlers, manager John Kiely and our own Donal O'Grady and the rest of the management team on winning their 23rd Munster Senior Hurling Championship, a first four-in-a-row last achieved by Limerick in 1933, 1934, 1935 and 1936 and become the first winners of the new Mackey Cup with a thrilling three point 1-29 to 0-29 victory after extra time over gallant neighbours Clare in difficult conditions at Semple Stadium, Thurles on Saturday played in front of a crowd of 45,500. Limerick are now through to the All Ireland semi final to be played on Sunday 3rd July in Croke Park against Wexford, Cork or Galway, time to be confirmed.
