Granagh Ballingarry Back on Track!

Limerick County Junior A Football Championship Group 2 Round 3

Granagh Ballingarry 2-13 Adare 0-4

Last years west and County Junior B Football champions and defeated Munster finalists Granagh Ballingarry defeated by St. Patricks in the opening round and forced to give a walkover to Adare in round 2 got their Limerick County Junior A Football Championship Campaign back on track with a comfortable fifteen point 2-13 to 0-4 victory over a gallant Adare second string fifteen at sun drenched Pair Caoimh Ui Luing, Feonagh on Sunday Afternoon. Michael Browne of Dromcollogher Broadford took charge of this county Junior A football championship group 2 round 3 to between 2020 and 2021 west junior B foot ball champions played on an excellent pitch in front of a small crowd for a championship

Both sides were guilty of inaccurate shooting in the opening five minutes before Granagh-Ballingarry no.13 Paudie Murphy finally finished Adare keeper Adam O'Callaghan on 5 minutes. Then white flags were traded from open play by Michael Southgate on 7 minutes and Paudie Murphy two minutes later to leave it 1-1 to 0-1 in favour of Granagh-Ballingarry on 9 minutes. A couple of wides were exchanged before a pail of white flags from open play for the Granagh-Ballingarry boys through Owen Lynch on 13 minutes and Paudie Murphy two minutes later to leave the boys in black and green five ahead 1-3 to 0-1 at the end of the first quarter. Then after 5 minutes of scoreless play Aaron Smith of Granagh-Ballingarry split the uprights from a placed ball on 21 minutes cancelled out from open play by Darragh Lane 3 minutes later to leave Granagh-Ballingarry boys still five ahead. 1-4 to 0-2 on 24 minutes. Both sides were guilty of inaccurate shooting particularly Granagh-Ballingarry in the next five minutes before Aaron Smith of Granagh-Ballingarry finally found his range when he split the uprights from a placed ball on 30 minutes to send the Granagh-Ballingarry boys in at the interval leading by six 1-5 to 0-2.

Aaron Smith from a placed ball and John Hourigan from open play traded white flags in the opening three minutes after the interval. A couple of wides exchanged before Granagh-Ballingarry dominated for 16 minutes with 5 unanswered white flags through Denis O'Connor (play) on 35 minutes, Paudie Murphy (play) on 37 minutes substitute Adam Long (play) 40 minutes Aaron Smith (45) on 43 minutes and (free) two minutes later to leave 11 between the sides. Granagh-Ballingarry 1-11 Adare 0-3 at the end of the third quarter. Then David O'Connor finally ended fourteen minutes without a Granagh-Ballingarry score when he split the uprights following a goal solo run on 47 minutes cancelled out by Aaron Smith 3 minutes later to restore the Granagh-Ballingarry boys eleven 11-point advantage on 50 minutes. Then after for minutes of scoreless play the second green flags of the game arrioved through Denis O'Connor of Granagh-Ballingarry who finished past Adare keeper Adam O'Callaghan following good work by Adam Long and Donal O'Grady to increase the boys in black and green advantage to 14 points 2-12 to 0-4 on 55 minutes. Then after 4 minutes of scoreless play Granagh-Ballingarry substitute Adam Long split the uprights from open play for the third time on 60 minutes. The final whistle sounded from the kickout to leave the Granagh-Ballingarry boys comfortable 15 point 2-13 to 0-4 winners of the 2 league championship points on offer the get the County Junior A football Championship campaign back on track after going under Adare and giving a walkover to Adare in the opening 2 rounds to go joint fourth in Group 2 on two points with St. Patricks and can now look forward with confidence to the next round against last years defeated finalists and table toppers Camogue Rovers on this Sunday 28th August in Banogue at 2pm. Granagh-Ballingarry scored 2-8 from play 0-4 from frees and 0-1 from a 45, Adare scored all 0-4 from play.
